### **Easter 2021 under Lockdown**

The working group discussed activities that Pontyclun Community Council could initiate as a way of celebrating Easter without offering prizes or encouraging social contact.

### **Recommendation**

The Social and Cultural Working Group recommend to the Council the following:

In mid March the Council:

1. asks Tara to refresh the facebook page that asks people to make pictures and crafts to place on the park railings, and painted pebbles to be placed alongside the railings. We will suggest that contributions are focused on an Easter theme of Hope and rebirth. We suggest that people may want to decorate their own front railings.
2. asks people to make Easter hats and to send photos to Pontyclun Community Council to put on the PCC facebook page;
3. asks the vicar of St Paul's if she is interested in designing and making an Easter Garden in Pontyclun Park and suggest that she does this in co-operation with other faith groups in the community;
4. asks Tara and some of the councillors create an Easter hunt. We place approximately 30 yellow correx eggs, bunnies and Easter symbols in shops and in the area. The form will be available on social media.
5. purchases and distributes small bundles of daffodils to the regular users of Café 50;
6. encourages Yarn mongers and others to knit hearts and butterflies and to hang these on the railings of the war memorial as part of the NHS campaign of hope
